July 2010 is the university's deadline to have either installed a fire control system in the current house or cease use of the current house. Alternative housing is available at a cost of \$50,000 per semester. The bid to install a fire control system is approximately \$32,000. The House Association members, at the annual meeting on September 12, 2009, concurred with the House Association Board's recommendation that installation of a fire control system in the current house is the appropriate interim alternative. Such will minimize the disruption of chapter activities and minimize costs for the chapter and House Association. Costs of the fire control system will be covered by chapter rent and House Association dues. None of the funds committed to the new house campaign will be utilized for the fire control system project.
