Dear Brother:

I am excited to be the newly elected President of the AGR House Association. It is the commitment we all make to a lifelong of service to the Fraternity that led me to accept this position to serve my fellow Brothers. However, there are two items that I want to bring to your attention in this mailing where all Brothers are expected to serve the Fraternity.

First, included in this letter is your annual invoice for payment of your House Association dues. The funds generated from these dues are critical to support the Fraternity House and the collegiate Brothers that call it home. With your help we are able to improve the living conditions and management of the House. Please mail in your dues to the address provided and help ensure that the immediate needs of the collegiate Brothers.

The second matter involves our plans to meet the future housing needs of the collegiate Brothers and that is our effort to raise funds to build a new fraternity House to serve the Fraternity for generations to come. We are estimating that it will take \$3,500,000 to prepare the site, construct and furnish the new house. The good news is that we are almost half way to getting the commitments to fund the project and this has been accomplished by only 20% of the Brothers. However, we think we can get a lower construction bid in these economic times on this project and thus, the sooner we can reach our fundraising goal, the better chance for us to further reduce the cost of the project.
