Dear Brothers:

The house is the center of the Fraternity experience. To meet the housing, scholastic, social, and Brotherhood needs of the Chapter, it is critical to have a functioning, safe house – one that we can all be proud of. Our current house is more than 35 years old and no longer meets these basic needs. I am proud to lead the Capital Campaign to fund construction of a new home for the Chapter.

How did we get here? Several years ago, as we struggled to address the maintenance and structural issues of the house, a committee was appointed to address the condition of the House. A feasibility study indicated it would be more cost-effective to construct a new house rather than renovate the old one. Another committee was appointed to develop a design. The committee toured other houses in the Southeast and, after discussion with the Brothers, adopted plans for a 22,190 square foot, three-story colonial structure to be constructed on the present site. The front elevation is pictured above.

What is the estimated cost and timeline for the project? We estimate the project will cost \$5 million. The goal is to have construction completed in August 2009.

What help is needed? We are challenging every Brother to make a personal financial commitment to the project. Donations are tax deductible.
